It has stood on Castle Rock in the old town since the 12<sup>th</sup> century. Historians say that this castle has seen more wars than any place in the world. It is one of the few ancient castles in Britain that still have an army.

B. One of the most important things kept in Edinburgh Castle is the Stone of Destiny. This ordinary-looking piece of rock has a very difficult history. It was used for crowning the kings of Scotland. It was later stolen by the kings of England and many wars were fought over it between the two countries for over 700 years before it was returned to its home.

It is popular with tourists as it is easy to climb and from there you can see beautiful views of the city. The name comes from the legends of King Arthur. Some people believe that the hill was the place where Camelot, the legendary castle of King Arthur, once stood.
